The **Wellness Program for Pets** is an exciting new program available to residents of El Paso and Teller counties. This program, which is provided under the direction of **Safe Place for Pets**, offers pet care assistance to pet owners who are focusing on their own end-of-life journey. Their beloved companion(s) are often struggling alongside their owner. This program strives to provide a level of consistent care to their faithful friends.



Who can benefit from the program? How do I qualify?

Qualifying is as easy as filling out an application. A Safe Place representative will then contact you with further details about our contract for services. The contract identifies services desired

for your pet(s) and frequency of need. There is no cost to participate in the program. Some services do have associated costs. Financial assistance is available for those who qualify.

How does the program work?

A Safe Place representative will discuss the process and review your contract for services. Once the services are approved, a volunteer will be assigned to carry out the care plan as agreed upon by **Safe Place for Pets** and the recipient.

What services does this program cover?

- ↳ Routine wellness visits with vet
- ↳ Transportation to vet or groomer
- ↳ Brushing/bathing/nail trims
- ↳ Dog/cat walks
- ↳ Pet playtime/exercising
- ↳ Pet sitting
- ↳ Litter box cleaning
- ↳ Doggie doo clean up
- ↳ Food/litter/collars/kennels/etc
- ↳ Delivery of pet food, treats, supplies
- ↳ Micro-chipping
